

Lamp Oil

Description

Lamp Oil is a Kerosene based product for use with modern ornamental Oil Lamps available in clear (EEC Countries).

Directions

Lamp Oil, should be used as direct by the original Lamp Oil manufacturer. See instructions for use, which accompanies individual products. Remove cap as instructed. After use, replace cap securely and store in safe place away from source of ignition. After lighting observe flame. A flame, which is too high, will cause unnecessary smoking. To alleviate this, lower the wick. It is essential the wick is kept trimmed.

Health and Safety

Harmful, may cause lung damage if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Do not breathe vapour. If swallowed do not induce vomiting and seek medical advice immediately. Avoid contact with skin. Repeated exposure may cause skin dryness and cracking. Keep lamps filled with this liquid out of reach of children. Never leave a burning lamp unattended.
